COMMUNITY WORKSHOPS

Learn about the work of Safe Passage, domestic violence, prevention, and how to support a friend or family member who is experiencing violence!

SAFE PASSAGE, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE & PREVENTION

3 HOURS

This training provides a more in depth orientation to Safe Passage services and domestic violence. In addition, participants will engage with our prevention programming to practice noticing skills, intervention tactics, and assertive communication through audience-specific scenarios.

Intended Audience: 18+

NOTE: This programming is regularly offered as our First Tier Volunteer Orientation. All participants will have the option to join our organization as First Tier Volunteers upon completion.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE & HOW TO SUPPORT SURVIVORS

1.5 HOURS

This workshop will include an overview of Safe Passage, domestic violence, and prevention strategies for community members and community organizations. We will gain information and skills to support survivors experiencing domestic violence, respond to disclosures, and take action to prevent violence in our community.

Intended Audience: 18+

NOTE: This programming is also offered to anyone in the community on a regular schedule as a virtual session. Contact outreach@safepass.org to learn when the next session is being held!

Safe Passage also offers the content in our community workshops in shorter, stand alone, programs that can be more conducive as a series or an introductory session. These include:

- Safe Passage 101 (30 mins)
- Domestic 101 (1 hour)

SAY SOMETHING PREVENTION LABS

8 HOURS (MULTI-SESSION)

Adult Prevention LABs (Intended audience 18+): Participants have the opportunity to build their bystander intervention skills while expanding their knowledge about the systems that contribute to domestic violence in our society. By the end, participants are empowered to intervene and prevent violence in their everyday lives.

Youth Prevention LABs (Intended audience 13+): Participants have the opportunity to build their assertive communication skills while expanding their knowledge about navigating consent and gain understanding of how gender impacts our experiences of violence. By the end, participants are empowered to build healthy relationships and prevent violence in their communities.
