What do Youth Advisors do?

- Meet other young leaders, discover and apply your leadership styles and strengths, and work together to support positive social change in your school.
- Meet bi-weekly with the Advisory Group to offer feedback and guidance about Say Something Youth Initiative programming at Easthampton High.
- Gain the skills to be a Say Something Youth Initiative ambassador in your school so you can support other students in getting involved!

What are the specifics?

- Introductory workshop for Youth Advisors 1 week before the first Advisory Group meeting.
- 4 Bi-weekly after school meetings each semester (October-December and March-June).
- There are ten (10) Youth Advisor positions available for EHS students each semester (Fall/Spring).
- Youth Advisors will be paid \$100 for each semester they participate as advisors.
- Advisors are asked to attend all meetings.
