

## COMMUNITY WORKSHOPS

### SAFE PASSAGE 101 (18+)

1 HOUR

Learn about Safe Passage programs, services, and approaches to supporting survivors and their families, engaging our community, and advocating for systemic change.

### DOMESTIC VIOLENCE 101 (18+)

1 HOUR

Explore a basic and comprehensive understanding of domestic violence. Through lecture, interactive activities, and discussion participants will become more confident in their understanding of domestic violence and skills to support friends, family, and community members who disclose experiencing violence.

### DOMESTIC VIOLENCE & HOW TO SUPPORT SURVIVORS (18+)

1.5 HOURS

This workshop will include an overview of Safe Passage, domestic violence, and prevention strategies for community members and community organizations. We will gain information and skills to support survivors experiencing domestic violence, respond to disclosures, and take action to prevent violence in our community.

### TEEN DATING VIOLENCE 101 (13+)

1.5 HOURS

Learn about resources and gain skills to notice troubling behaviors as you build relationships. This workshop is designed to meet the unique strengths and needs of teens in our community.

### PREVENTION 101 (18+)

1 HOUR

Learn basic tips and skills for recognizing situations that contribute to violence in our community. In addition to learning recognition skills, intervention tactics for bystanders will be reviewed and audience-specific scenarios in each workshop for practice of assertive communication skills.

### SAY SOMETHING PREVENTION LABS

8 HOURS (MULTI-SESSION)

**Adult Prevention LABs (18+):** Build bystander intervention skills while expanding knowledge about the systems that contribute to violence in our society. By the end, participants are empowered to intervene and prevent violence in their everyday lives.

**Youth Prevention LABs (13+):** Build assertive communication skills while expanding knowledge about navigating consent and gain understanding of how gender impacts our experiences of violence. By the end, participants are empowered to build healthy relationships and prevent violence in their communities.
